### **Surrey Schools ANTI BULLYING CONTESTS**

**Contest for K – 5 to win an iPodNano** Beginning February 6 students will be invited to submit their short stories, art work or mini videos depicting a strong anti-bullying message on the PSST site. Upon conclusion of the contest, on February 24, three winning entries will be chosen. The winners will be announced on February 29, 2012, Anti-Bullying Day, on the site, and will be contacted separately. Each chosen entry will receive an iPod Nano.

All submissions which meet the requirements below, will be able to be viewed on the PSST site.

Requirements:

- The image/story/poem must depict a strong anti-bullying message
- If writing a full length article, story, or poem - submission must be a minimum of 200 words
- Use proper spelling and grammar
- Language and content must be appropriate for all age groups
- If names are included in the writing, please ensure that they are not those of actual people
- Include a photo with submission

**Contest for Grade 6 - 12 to win Acting / Singing Training Money** To raise awareness of the PSST website, Protecting Surrey Schools Together, we are starting a new contest to get students actively thinking about anti-bullying. Beginning on February 20, 2012, students, Grade 6 and up, will be invited to submit 30 second to one minute videos, depicting an anti-bullying interpretation through acting or singing, to the PSST site. Once the video submission period concludes on March 2, 2012, the submissions will be evaluated by school district staff, as well as PSST Sponsor, RSA Academy, on the basis of creativity, talent and achievement of criteria. From there, serious applicants will be asked to a live audition where two winners will be chosen, one for acting and one for singing. All videos that meet the required criteria will also be featured on the PSST site, a great opportunity to share our local talent with the rest of the district.

The winners will each receive training in their respective fields from RSA Academy, a combined prize of \$9,800.
