Budget

HOT LUNCH UPDATE

Brenda Seter was unavailable so Wendy spoke on her behalf. We are very appreciated to a parent who donated the first Hot Dog Day Hot Lunch. What a Huge Success. It was also noted from a parent that Schneider's Meats was closing in May and its final closing the doors is in September.

Lynn Re: The Social – Ticket Sales to date are so far at 6,500.00 for the Raffle. We also have the square board & the baskets for the silent auction. There have been over 100 tickets sold for the social to date. Labatt`s is donating a beer tasting night that will be for March 12th. There were also talks of a Limo Co. donating a limo to the tasting. Karen & Tricia`s donations so far have been amazing.

DPAC UPDATE – **Cara** Allan Jones spoke for the Eastside & Rick Fabro for the Westside & North, and Pat Horstead spoke on behalf of the Southside. The discussion lead to Information about Tweedsmuir High School and the overcrowding. Next Mtg is April 27th and the guest speaker is Diane Watts.

Health Committee – Re: Karen – Karen was absent so Wendy spoke on her behalf and questions & concerns were raised that Joanne spoke briefly, regarding the Lice within our school among students that has not been contained or treated and parents feel it is a health risk. Very concerning. Parents asked if we could supply kits, or help in anyway. Due to privacy and concern for the girls and their families there is nothing we can do. Teresa feels that we should be doing more to get this under control along with more parents who raise concerns that it will never get better. Joanne has mentioned that we let the school deal with it in a matter of another letter to go home raising concerns etc.

Playground Committee - Holly

Meeting was postponed till March 1st. Joanne did however comment on the fill replacement & the cost that is now being put on the PAC to pay for instead of the original proposal of \$24,000. They have agreed to split the costs and pay 50% leaving a balance of 12 thousand dollars for the soft fill (synthetic wood chips) for the community effort to fundraise the remainder.

SPC Update - Cara & Roslyn no update

PAC Website & School Pac Newsletter – Lisa Keeling commented on the idea of local businesses or independent businesses advertising on the website with a fee of \$25 per year. Lisa feels there are not enough hits to make this worthwhile. It was commented to raise the fee to \$40 but in agreement the \$25 seemed fair. There is more work involved so if it were to happen it would not be an easy job.
